Inductive Bible Study Method:

- Observation: Look for key words, admonitions, questions, contrasts, comparisons, illustrations, connectives, etc.
- Interpretation: Interpreting is helped by asking questions, comparing translations, defining words, studying cross-references, wrestling with meanings, etc.

Helpful steps of interpretation:

- A. Pray and meditate.
- B. Discern. It is always helpful to ask questions:

· Why did the main characters say _	?
What is the meaning of	?
What is the significance of	?
What is the implication of	?
· What is the relationship between	1

- C. Define. Pick key words in the passage and get a Biblical definition of what those words meant to the author.
- D. Compare. Look at different translations. When Bible scholars translate a particular version of the Bible, they are also interpreting. Look at different translations to see other possible understandings of the passage.
- E. Consult. This is where a few commentaries can be very helpful.
- F. Summarize.
- 3. Summarize: You can do this by bracketing verses and summarizing key ideas.
- 4. Evaluate: What value do these words have today?
- **5. Apply**: What are these words saying to you personally as it relates to what the original intent of the author was?
- **6. Actualize:** What are you going to do about the truth that you have just learned? This is the step in which you make an action plan to obey.
